



For a Better Tomorrow: Social Enterprises on the Move” FAB-MOVE

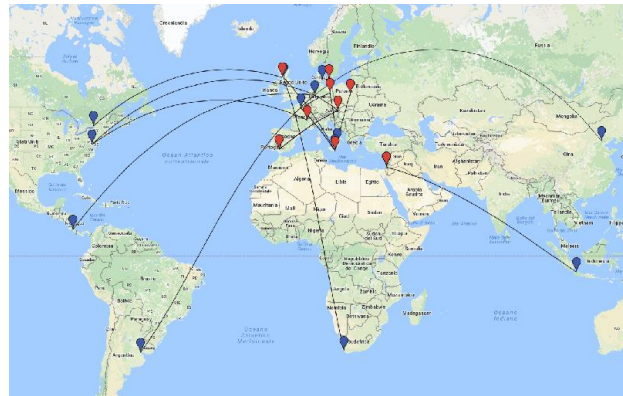
The project brings together researchers and practitioners in order to explore the question of how social enterprises can grow and flourish.
