



# ERASMUS+ KA220 Project: Allophone Teacher Academy ALTA

The ALTA project aims to meet the European challenges in terms of training educational staff involved in the inclusion of allophone populations. The ALTA project is in line with the European policy promoting equal opportunities, the fight against discrimination, and the mastery of the language of instruction, and will target in priority serving teachers and student teachers in contact with allophone pupils.

The ALTA project is part of these global strategies and will meet the challenges of the Erasmus + teachers academies:

- By being intended to teachers and student teachers of allophone pupils, recently arrived in partner territories, its aim is to support and allow special needs pupils to access inclusive learning of the language of instruction used in their school;
- By enabling the exchange of innovative teaching practices, that are suitable for this audience, this project will allow teachers and student teachers to develop skills and disseminate European values.

The ALTA project will also facilitate their networking and enable the maintaining of virtual and physical mobility projects over time.

- Reinforce the structuring of the initial training/ beginning of the teaching career/ in-service training continuum for teachers in contact with allophone pupils, who have just arrived on the territory or whose native language is not the language of instruction.
