SuperScienceMe is a dip into the knowledge in search of scientific and cultural wonders

The project conveys the message that "research is an inexhaustible (re)source of inspiration to make Europe better for the next generation". In line with Horizon Europe's five missions, SuperScienceMe addresses MSCA and Citizen 2022 scope to motivate young people in "shaping more beautiful, sustainable and inclusive forms of living together." SuperScienceMe brings research results into schools of urban, suburban, and rural areas in two neighbouring regions of Southern Italy (Calabria and Basilicata with more than 3.800 schools) to help build a science-literate society. The 2022-2023 NIGHT editions will support schoolteachers in developing a scientific informal education for a "school beyond the school" to learn from the present/past and to build the future of research.
